



Genus – Call for Papers for the Special Issue

“The legacy of Corrado Gini in population studies”

The Italian Statistical Society (SIS) organized an international conference on “Statistics and demography: the legacy of Corrado Gini”, hosted at the Treviso campus of the Ca' Foscari University, on September 2015. This conference has been the occasion to investigate those research themes Corrado Gini has contributed to during the last century in Statistics, Economics, Demography, Biology, Sociology and Official Statistics, and to outline the impact that most of his themes still have on current research in theoretical and applied statistics and demography.

The journal GENUS (<http://www.genus-journal.org>), which is going to join SPRINGER, is an international journal founded in 1934 by Corrado Gini. The main focus of GENUS is on the interdisciplinary approach to population studies, both from theoretical and applied point of view.

Fifty years after Gini's death, Genus opens a call for papers to be published in a special issue on “The Legacy of Corrado Gini in population studies”; the issue aims at collecting papers that have been presented at the SIS2015 meeting and that discuss the links between the research developed by Corrado Gini and current research topics in theoretical and applied demography and more broadly in population studies.

The proposals for the special issue must be uploaded on the website of the Journal by 20 November 2015 to undergo the usual review process of Genus (see <http://scistat.cilea.it/index.php/genus/about>) that assures the publication at the very beginning of the next year.
